**Photograph**- A picture made using a camera

**Landscape** - A screen display that is wider than it is high

**Portrait** - A screen display that is higher than it is wide

**Subject** - A person or thing that is being photographed

**Focus** - The state of producing clear visual definition

**Background** - Forms a setting for the main figures or objects, or appears furthest from the viewer

**Editing** - To make a change or correction
