The power supplied by something.

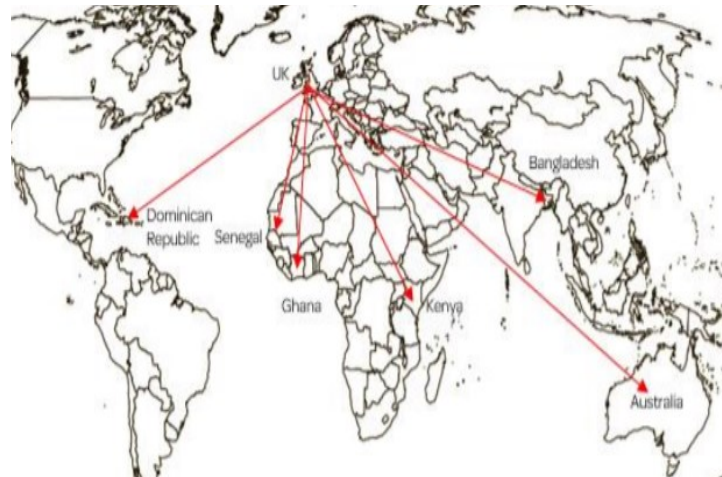
Transportation
