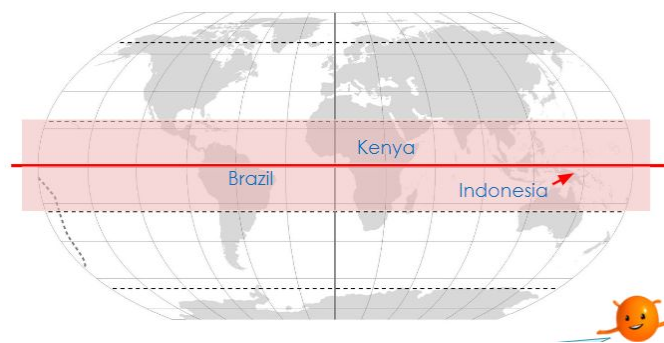

**The Equator**- an imaginary line around the middle of a planet.  
**North Pole** - the point that is farthest north on the planet Earth.  
**South Pole** - the point that is farthest south on the planet Earth.  
**Adapt** - finding ways to survive in a place.  
**Desert**- a place where almost no rain falls.  
**Rainforest** - a tall, dense forest that receives lots of rain every year.  
**Savanna** - Tropical, flat grasslands with scattered trees and shrubs. Found near the equator.  
**Habitat** - the natural home of an animal or plant.
