Dear Parent/Carer

Another week and it appears that the winter has started to bite. Frosty mornings give way to beautiful sunny days so although we may be cold to begin with, we soon warm up and benefit from the spectacular sights around.

The value that we are looking at this week is determination. The 'grit' and perseverance skills we must teach our pupils so that they don't lose heart when they receive constructive and developmental feedback from adults to improve their work. In order to meet the higher standards that we need to, often children need to redouble their efforts and accept that their work can always be improved. We will be focussing on this process this term as a staff and we ask that you support us. If you haven't ever seen Austin's butterfly video, you can watch it here. It is quite a powerful tool demonstrating how feedback and perseverance can bring about excellent outcomes.

COVID-19

As expected the spread of the Omicron variant is rapid and within our local and school community. Adults and children are affected and we need your help in ensuring that we maintain a lid on the transmission as much as possible. Thank you to those of you who have shared with us that your child has received a positive lateral flow test result. If you have done that this week, your child should isolate for 7 days from the test result. Lateral flow tests should be completed on day 6 and 7 and if negative, your child will be able to come back to school. This week, many of you will know that the government intends to change the isolation rules from 7 days to 5 days. This will take effect from Monday 17th January. From this date, pupils and adults who test positive on a LF device will need to isolate for 5 days and test negative on day 5 and the morning of day 6 before returning to school. Please note that the first test must be taken no earlier than day 5 of the self-isolation period, and the second must be taken the following day. All test results should be reported to NHS Test and Trace.

This week we were visited by the director of education of River Learning Trust who supported the school with pupil progress meetings and identifying interventions following the results of assessments before Christmas. This means we are now able to effectively target your child for extra practice or small group work to help them fill in the gaps in knowledge they may have. We look forward to demonstrating the progress we are making when we have our peer review in a few weeks time.

Finally, we hope that our DEN will be back for children's use next week. It has been out of action as we have had some building work completed to install a nurture sensory space. We hope to be able to show you pictures of it soon.

The children in Sparrow and Wren classes have been learning about how germs spread when we sneeze and do not cover our mouth and nose and what happens when you do not wash your hands.
















