
Dear Parent/Guardian

Thank you for getting your child to school on time this week. Whenever the weather turns cold or wet, often we can use that as an excuse to be late. You will have noticed the dojo message from the school office this week showing what your child should be doing in school from the start of the day. Remember that our gates open at 8:25 and work is available for the children from that time. If your child only gets to school at 8:50 then they have already missed out on some learning. That 20 mins is vital as if they miss that time regularly then they miss out on learning. 20 mins a day for 190 days equates to just over 63 hours of learning missed. Worth thinking about.

Today's assembly was the last one about determination before we move on to the value of courage next week. I showed the children a video clip about being determined. The Heather <u>Dorniden race</u> and the importance of try, try and <u>try again</u>. It is extremely important that the children know and understand that success does not come easily. That gaining knowledge requires effort and on that journey to acquire new knowledge sometimes we will fail and we must learn from those failures. I reintroduced the picture of the Learning Pit. Good learners are unafraid to be in the learning pit where they get to demonstrate their determination to succeed. I include the image below. Please talk to your child about how important it is to be determined to succeed.

We continue to be supported and challenged by the Trust and yesterday we conducted a maths review. Subject leaders and senior leaders joined our support and challenge partner (Felix Rayner) to scrutinise pupil progress and teaching quality in mathematics. I am pleased that the initial reports are extremely positive. There is always something to work on however and we will continue to learn and develop in order to provide your children with the best learning experiences that they deserve.








