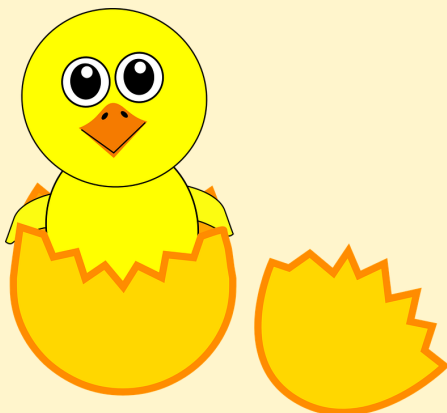
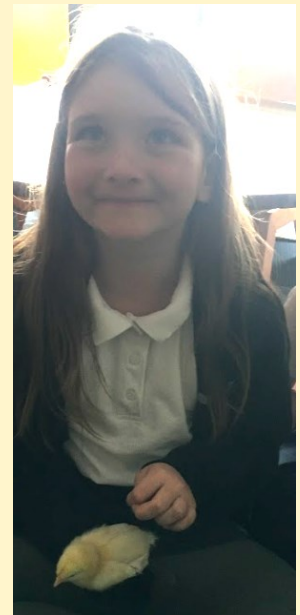

FARM VISIT

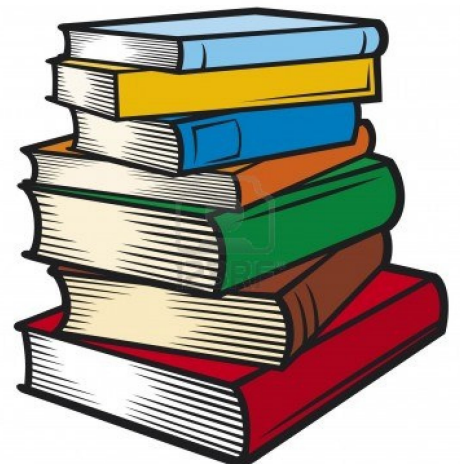
