Children in early years have been making their own wrapping paper for birthday bears present

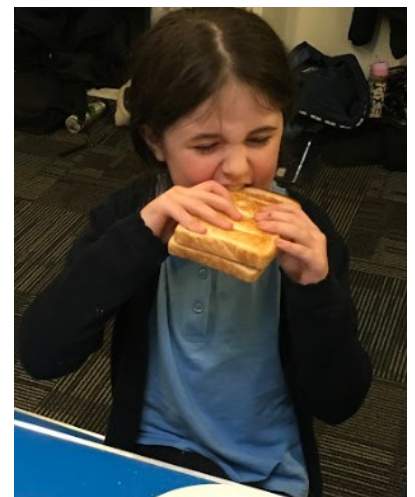




Year 6 have been making Italian bread and Italian dishes in their DT lesson this week. It smelt lovely and filled the whole school with the smell of Italy
