I hope you managed to read our Ofsted report from our visit in early September. While we were disappointed with the overall outcome there was a lot to celebrate in achieving Good in Leadership and Management, Behaviour and Attitudes, Personal Development and Early Years.

"The report recognised that pupils 'enjoy coming to Seven Fields' and that 'parents talk positively about the school's family feel and the role it plays in the local community'.

"The inspector also wrote that 'pupils feel safe' and that 'they have warm and trusting relationships with adults'.

"The report praised our direction of travel and said that 'the school's actions are bringing about rapid improvements', but said 'the school's vision is yet to be fully realised'.

"That last statement is something we certainly do agree with, as we have huge ambition to make this a school that provides the most amazing education possible for children from the fantastic community that we serve.

"We look forward to being able to demonstrate that we do this when Ofsted visits next time."

The importance of ensuring your child attends school is paramount. We make no apologies if you have received a reminder letter that your child is falling into the below average or even persistent absentee category. Remember that percentages are calculated from how much time they have spent in school so far. As the year is still relatively young, each day holds a greater percentage. In assembly each week I give out the award for the best class. The children are keen to receive these awards so please try to get them to school on time as often as possible.

Thank you for your attendance at parents evening at the end of last term. We will be sending out a short survey this term to get your feedback on how we organise Parents evenings.

The silent disco, run so brilliantly by the PTA, was such a success last night. Thank you for once again supporting our endeavours to raise funds for the school.




