## Kingfishers - During computing the children used the crop tool to change the composition of images

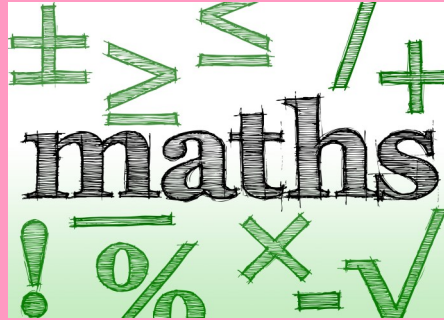


## Robins - In their Science lesson this week we had a look at how animals camouflage and learnt about Arctic animals

Silver badges for Theo, Kyron, Catherine and Olivia for reaching 60 house points



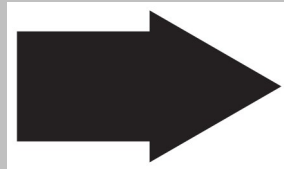
