Lesson 1	Explain why we make agreements and how these help us. Understand how there are agreements in Religions.	Commandments— Rules that God made to tell people how to live.	
Lesson 2	Children will know the story of Abraham and Isaac and understand that God made a Covenant with the Jews.	Covenant— An agreement between two or more people.	
Lesson 3	Children will identify and understand the ten commandments and what they mean.	Agreement— When people feel or think the same way about something, they agree. Sometimes it is important to write down or make a promise to what has been agreed on.	
Lesson 4	Children will know what the Mezuzah is and understand its importance in the Jewish home.	Torah—In Hebrew the word Torah means “to teach” or “to show the way.”	
Lesson 5	To understand Jewish people’s relationship with God and discuss how this is special.

Mezuzah—A mezuzah is a small box that is placed on the right doorpost of Jewish homes. Inside the box is a parchment scroll with verses from the Torah inscribed on it.
