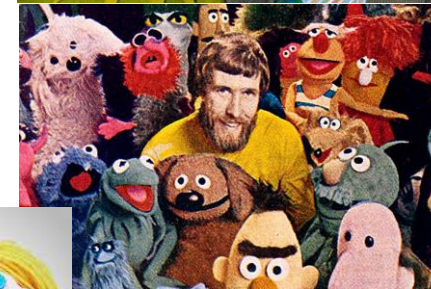
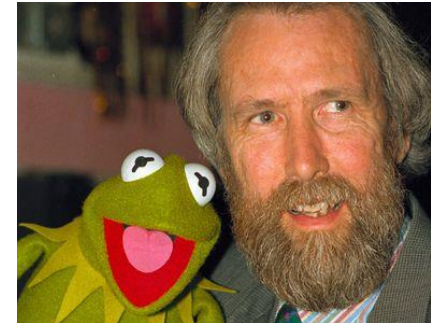

Eye – the eye of the needle is the small hole at the top, which the thread goes through.



Stitch – a loop of thread made by passing the needle through a piece of material.

Textile – a type of cloth or woven fabric. This could include felt, denim, and satin.

Thread – a long, thin piece of cotton used for sewing.
