Shabbat: Sabbath – A day of rest

Kippah: skull cap

Sacrifice - the act of giving up something of great value to show loyalty or deep affection.

Covenant - A special relationship based on shared promises.

The Torah - The Jewish holy book.

Commandment - one of the Ten Commandments or laws given to Moses by God.

Kiddush - a blessing said by Jews at the start of Shabbat and holiday meals.

Rabbi - the chief religious official of a synagogue, who often leads worship and conducts rites and rituals.
