

English:

This term we are going to be looking at Narrative with a key focus on Myths. Our main unit will be closely linked to our main Topic as we will explore Ancient Greek Myths. Our recap unit will be looking at Poetry, which again, will be focused around the Ancient Greeks. Within Guided Reading, we will be exploring a new class text called, 'Who let the Gods out' by Julia Willis. We will be looking at the way that the different characters are written and the use of dialogue, to help us with our own writing.

Maths:

In Maths this term we will be looking at calculating area, perimeter and volume before moving on to ratio and proportion.

Science:

This term our Science unit will be focused on the human body and healthy eating. We will be looking at ways to stay healthy and the effects that different substances have on our health.

French:
